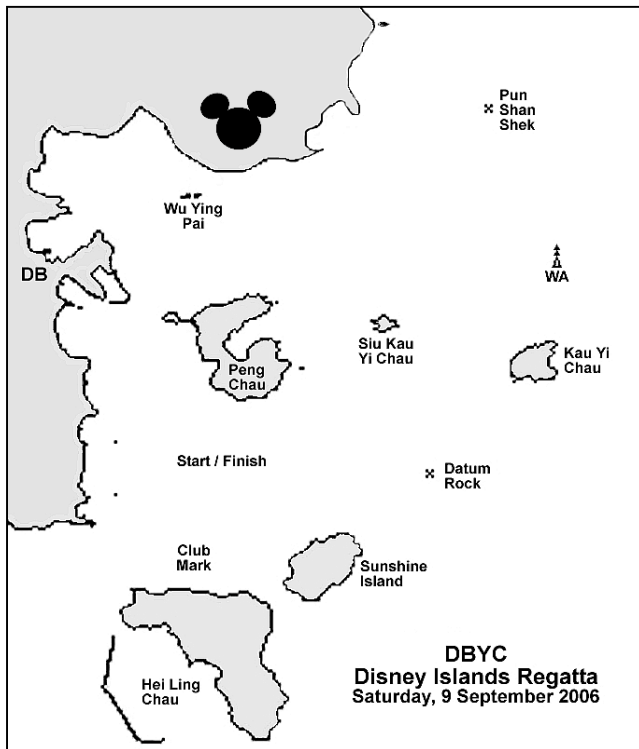


# DISCOVERY BAY YACHT CLUB



## Notice of Race & Entry Form Disney Islands Regatta – 11<sup>th</sup> November 2007

**Entries are invited for the DBYC Disney Islands Regatta, scheduled for Sunday, 11<sup>th</sup> November 2007.**



The Regatta is open to all DBYC members, or members of any HKSF-affiliated club. Eligible boats may be entered by submitting the attached entry form to the DBYC by 1700 hours on Friday, 9<sup>th</sup> November 2007.

Entry fee is \$200; late entries may be accepted upon payment of an additional \$100 late entry fee.

The event will consist of two races over local islands courses, scheduled as follows:

- 0900 Skippers briefing in DB Marina Club**
- 1030 Start 1, just South of Peng Chau**
- 1400 Start 2**
- 1700 Approx finish**
- 1800 Prize-giving on Bilge Bar terrace**

Prizes will be awarded for Line Honours and for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places in each race on handicap-corrected time. Prizes will also be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places overall, employing the modified Low Point scoring system.

Boats will be handicapped by HKPN, or DBPN (issued by the DBYC) if no HKPN is available. The DBYC Handicapping Committee reserves the right to adjust existing HKPN handicaps as required by conditions, in order to fairly balance the performance of all boats entered.

Berthing will be possible, at normal rates and on a space-available basis, at the DB Marina Club. Participating crews may use the Marina Club bar and restaurant as a guest of, and in company with, a Marina Club member. Credit card payment will be accepted.

2. **Please submit entries by 1700 hrs on Wednesday, 6<sup>th</sup> September.** Entries received after this date will be considered as Late Entries and incur an additional late entry fee.
3. The DBYC Disney Islands Regatta will be governed by the ISAF Racing RRS 2005-08, the Prescriptions of the HKSF, and the DBYC Standard Racing Instructions (SRI). All boats shall comply with the current edition of the ORC Special Regulations Category 4, and shall hold valid third party insurance. **The Race Committee may exclude from the race any boat that does not meet the required safety standards.**
4. The attention of all competitors is drawn to the Fundamental Rules in Part 1 of the RRS, particularly with respect to the safety of a boat and her crew being the sole responsibility of the Skipper, who must ensure that the boat is seaworthy and properly equipped and that the crew are able to cope with emergencies and poor weather conditions.
5. All those taking part in the event do so at their own risk and responsibility. Each boat is solely responsible for the decision to race or to continue racing. Entrants shall note and advise all crew members that competitors participate at their own risk and that the DBYC does not accept any liability for any loss or damage to persons or property that may result from such participation.
