### Entries

Boats may join the TMR at any stage - at Discovery Bay on Friday evening for the Bilge Bar 'meet and greet', Saturday morning in time for Race 1, or at the Gold Coast in time for Race 2.

Race entries will be accepted up to Wednesday, 25<sup>th</sup> April. Entries after that date may still be accepted with payment of a late entry fee, but early booking would be appreciated, so that berthing and catering arrangements can be made on your behalf.

Motor vessels are very welcome, entry gratis if assisting as guard vessels through 'the gap'.

### Berthing

Discovery Bay Marina Club and Gold Coast Yacht & Country Club are kindly sponsoring the event and berthing at both marinas will be free for participants during the weekend of the race. See the marina plans overleaf for the TMR berthing areas. Note the 'X' which marks the focus for the welcoming ice-cold dockside beers for the crews after each race – generously sponsored by *Cerveza Sol*.

### Catering

The regatta entry fee of \$800 includes full buffet dinner for **up to 4 crew from each boat** at the GCYCC prize-giving on Saturday night, and the Headland BBQ buffet for **all racing and support crew** back at Discovery Bay on Sunday afternoon.

Additional Gold Coast dinner tickets can be ordered on the entry form at a price of \$160 or \$110 for sub-teens. All payment to be made through DBYC - cheques or cash will be accepted in advance, with

the entry form, or a limited quantity may be available on the day. Please order early to avoid disappointment.

The Discovery Bay Headland BBQ will be gratis for racing crews; additional meals will be available for purchase on the day through the Marina Club, on a pay-as-you-dine basis. Alternatively, families are very welcome to bring a picnic. A bar service will also be provided.

## Accommodation

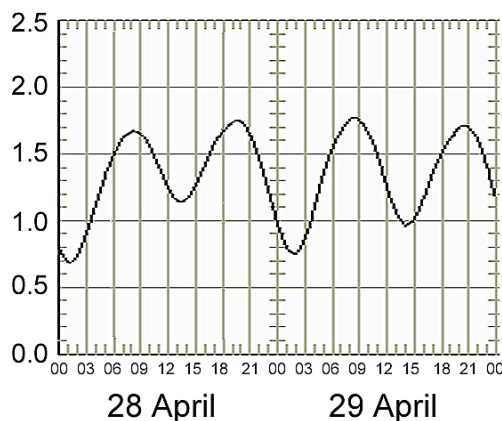

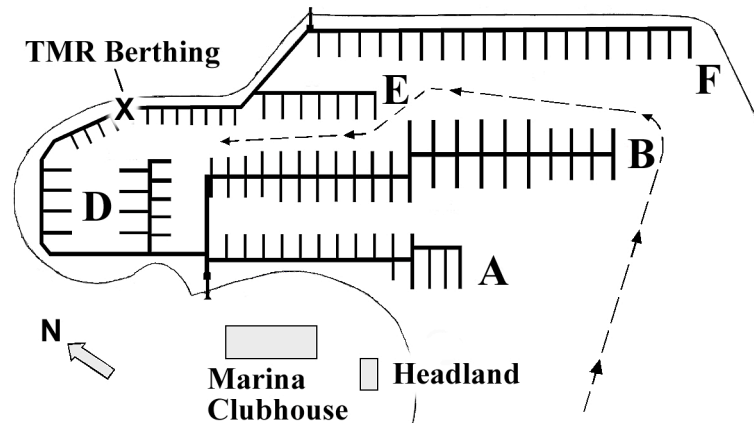

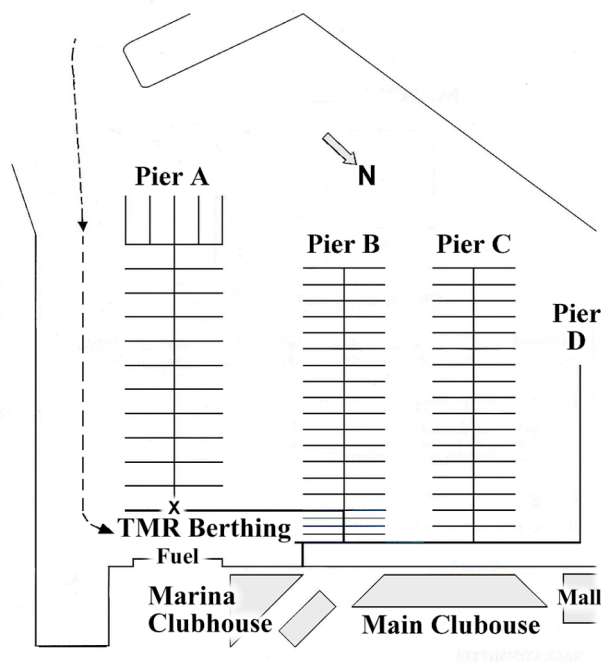




## Discovery Bay Berthing

TMR visiting boats up to 40 ft LOA have been allocated the free berths on the North edge of D-dock, from berths D30-D52. Please moor as close to the 'X' as possible for the dockside arrival beer and regatta group photo. Boats >40 ft LOA should contact the Marina Club direct for berthing on a space-available basis.

**Note: The larger 55-65 ft berths in D-dock are out of commission due to work in progress and are not to be used.**



## Gold Coast Berthing

TMR visiting boats have been allocated the free berths on the North end of Pier A, opposite the Fuel Berth, as shown here. First come, first served, but please park as close to the 'X' as possible for the dockside arrival beer and subsequent regatta group photo. Feel free to 'dress' your boat...
